### Wellbeing Resources

Pupils from S2 and S3 have been actively involved in Education Scotland's Young Leaders of Learning programme, demonstrating a strong commitment to improving the experiences of others. Working in partnership with Trinity High School, they identified key areas for development and collaborated to create and implement a meaningful action plan.

Through their work, the pupils recognised that awareness of mental health and wellbeing support across the school could be strengthened. In response, they developed a range of updated, accessible resources to ensure that all young people feel informed, supported and cared for. This reflects our core value of nurture, as they have placed the wellbeing of their peers at the centre of their work.

Our S2 Young Leaders recently presented their project to pupils and staff from across the authority, including the Director of Education. They have also been invited to present their work to members of Renfrewshire Council later in the year, a fantastic recognition of their efforts and impact.

As part of their project, the team has created posters to be displayed throughout the school, helping to signpost young people to available supports. They have also designed business cards, which will be given to all new S1 pupils, and developed a slide that will be shared at the start of every assembly going forward.

## Get Ready for the New School Year

### School Uniform

Please remember, there is no need to buy everything on the list as the new items have been added to make the uniform more accessible and inclusive to everyone. I have outlined the uniform items below for information:

- Plain black trousers, shorts or skirt (no jeans, tracksuit/jogging bottoms, combats etc)
- White shirt and school tie **or** school branded polo shirt
- Plain black jumper **or** school branded  $\frac{3}{4}$  zip top (no hooded tops)
- Blazer (optional but advised)
- Black footwear

### Free School Meals and Clothing Grants

School clothing grant and free school meals applications are now open. These applications are for the new school year starting in August.

You could save up to £889.75 per secondary school child by applying. This total saving is for both a school clothing grant and free school meals.

Apply by Sunday 12<sup>th</sup> July and Renfrewshire Council will process your application before the new term starts.

Anyone on Universal Credit can earn up to £995 per month and still be eligible.

The Council provides holiday payments for free school meals. Payments are £2.35 per day per child. They cover the October, Christmas, February, Easter and summer holidays.
